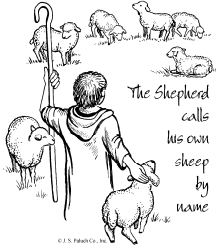

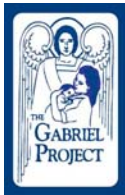

### **LET'S END MODERN SLAVERY!**

Did you know that you can help reduce human slavery by purchasing products labeled "Fair Trade"? This is how we support the companies that sell us our food and other products who ensure that no human slavery was used in their supply and production chain. Yes, these items usually cost more, but that is because they are not being produced using slave or under-compensated labor.) The US State Department estimates that 21 million men, women and children are being held in some kind of forced labor—modern slavery. (Other human rights groups put the number at 35 million.) These are some of the people who harvest our food, make our clothes, gather the raw materials made for electronics, jewelry and makeup, or who are sold for "adult pleasure". They are not only in far-off places, but right here in the Monterey Bay region. What can we do? First of all, educate ourselves. **SAINTS OF THE WEEK:**

**May 10:** *Blessed Damien of Moloka'i, priest.* Born in Belgium in 1840, Damien joined the Fathers of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary at age 20. In 1873, at his request, he was sent to the leper colony at Moloka'i. He spent the rest of his life ministering to the lepers. At age 45 he contracted leprosy and died four years later.

**May 12:** *Sts. Nereus & Achilleus, martyrs.* Two soldiers in the Roman army of the first century, Nereus and Achilleus refused to continue in military service when they became Christians. For this they were condemned and killed. They were buried in a cemetery on the Ardeantine Way where a basilica was eventually built in their honor.

*St. Pancras, martyr.* Little is known about him other than he was killed for being a Christian at age 14 around 304.
