The Bishop has suspended the Sunday mass obligation indefinitely since many people still need to stay at home, and we will continue to live stream our 9 AM weekday and our 10:15 AM Sunday mass.

You'll be able to see and hear everything, but we won't be able to hear you if you want to share a prayer intention or peace greeting (but God will hear you!)

#### Option 2: Zoom (interactive)

**From a smart phone or tablet:**

2. Enter Meeting ID 429 472 279 and #

An email will be sent on Saturdays with a convenient one-click link for computer users and a link to a worship aid for all. A link will also be placed on our website. A Zoom Visual Aid is available on our website.

You may wish to have a trial run by logging on ahead of time. If you get to a page that says "This meeting has not started" then you've succeeded!

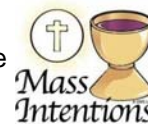
- How do you sense God "tugging" at you throughout

# Senior Resource Ministry

A Reflection by Erma Coty

I was watching a morning show and the guest was talking about the origin of the familiar phrase “e pluribus unum”. It is the traditional motto of the USA appearing on the great seal. We see it so often that we seldom think of the meaning or who actually said it.

A brief Google search traced the words back to the Greek philosopher Cicero. After looking for a scholarly site to use I found that the accepted translation is the following:

***‘When each person loves the other as much as himself, it makes one out of many’***

It started me thinking about how I often look to inspirational quotes to guide me in my daily life. I have, since college, been drawn to books of quotations to inspire me and perhaps to quote in an assignment. I can still open an anthology of poetry or Bartlett’s Book of Familiar Quotations and entertain myself for hours finding a quote that best fits my mood at that moment. Or I might just find that browsing around in a familiar book soothes my soul.

Now of course, I can look up inspirational quotes on the computer and the internet will miraculously deliver hundreds of sayings that I can look through and enjoy. In fact, I can find a poem to read just by remembering one line. Or I can find the words to a song I can follow while listening to it on You Tube. But there is nothing as satisfying as thumbing through page after page of memorable words some of which I’m reading for the first time.

I am guessing that many of us recall favorite sayings or quotations that either help us through hard times or inspire us in some way. Perhaps there is a special prayer that we committed to memory that automatically comes to mind when we need a spiritual boost. I know that one particular quote was helpful to me when my roommate was determined to convince me to wake up for an early breakfast. I, on the other hand, was determined to find the perfect response to her persistence (bullying?) that was on point but not mean. Anonymous saved me with the saying “The anvil outlasts the hammer”. Today this is attributed to various sources but in 1965 I found it in a book of quotations titled “Leaves of Gold”.

We are in the eighth month of living with the necessary and possibly lifesaving restrictions because of COVID-19, with shorter days and increased hours spent inside. We can spend a moment recalling the special words that guided us when we needed inspiration. It might be fun to share stories with friends and family about the words that helped us through our daily lives. It is a good reminder that words matter. Words are powerful and enduring, which is why we still honor the words Cicero used sometime before he died in the year 43 BCE. I hope my children remember my kind words and not the tired, salty words that I have often used in my lifetime.



Estelle Turner shared a prayer with me. She remembered it from a retreat she attended at the Villa Maria Del Mar, led by Fr. Fish. It is a wonderful example of the power of words and the lasting power of prayer. I am sharing it as well.
