Middle School & High School Youth Ministry:

In light of the current circumstances due the Coronavirus we will not be running our Middle School and High School Youth Group programs through December. We will re-evaluate the situation at that time.

Youth Confirmation:

Confirmation is open to all High School Youth, beginning in 9th Grade. It is a two-year program. **In light of the current circumstances due the Coronavirus all Juniors and Seniors will enter as 2nd year participants and will only be required to complete one year.**

- *At this time, participants will only be required to attend one Confirmation meeting a month.* Confirmation 1st year 2nd year will meet separately.
- The requirements for Confirmation 1st & 2nd year will be adjusted as needed due to the Coronavirus. (These could include youth group meetings, retreats, special events, volunteer and community service activities for the parish and larger community).
- This year due to Covid and the uncertainty that retreats and special events can take place, we are adjusting the price for confirmation from \$225 to \$100. In the event that any of these activities can take place we will collect the fees at that time.

- **Please be sure to register before the first session of Confirmation 2nd Year (October 10) & Confirmation 1st Year (October 24)**

OUTREACH

FOOD PANTRY: Our Food Pantry serves the needs of the poorest of our community each Monday and Friday morning from 10:00 AM to noon. Thanks to being an official distribution center for the Second Harvest Food Bank, and your generous donations, we have plenty of food to offer those who need it. Throughout the pandemic we haven’t had to purchase any food from Second Harvest. All food from Second Harvest has been given to us free. We are so grateful for our generous volunteers who come each week to serve the clients and to make the food bags and keep everything organized. Truly Christ is revealed in the breaking of the bread!

FUNDS TO HOUSE THE HOMELESS AVAILABLE!

300 new housing vouchers available for those without homes, and our Association of Faith Communities (our shelter organization) is looking for rental units to house People currently in our shelter and Safe Spaces (parking) programs. If you have rental unit available, the AFC will refer our best candidates to you for consideration.

The County Housing Authority will pay the rent at market value, and is currently offering a \$2,000 bonus to most landlords who rent to individuals with a voucher. Also, Landlords can be reimbursed up to \$5000 for damages that exceed the security deposit, unpaid rent, vacancy loss or legal fees.

Landlords have the benefit of direct deposit, a landlord portal, a single point of contact- the Leasing Specialist, and the security of knowing that the rent will be paid, even if a tenants income decreases.

The properties eligible must not be a room in your house but an area with a separate entrance and bath/cooking areas.

A Reflection by Erma Coty

Not long ago a friend and I were sharing ways to manage the many challenges that we may face in this second year dealing with the pandemic. It is not surprising to find that as time passes, the effects of isolation and decreased social activity, can present individuals with unique life altering opportunities. Or with daunting adversity and significant changes in usual behaviors.

What seems to be clear is that how we respond to each unexpected hurdle ultimately determines how we develop as human beings. Yes, we continue to learn and grow no matter how old we are. We choose how we move forward and how we influence those we care about. My friend reminded me that we can follow the example of those who helped uplift us along the way or else retreat to the sidelines, advocating neither that which helps us move forward nor that which impedes our progress.

I think it is a good time to remember those who we believe set the best example for us. Many may recall a teacher who had a profound influence on their life. Others look up to role models who have demonstrated kindness, consideration and supportive behavior through their life. We are fortunate to have Pope Francis as a spiritual leader who reminds us to be humble and to serve those who are in need. For most of us, there was someone at some moment who compelled us to pause and consider what kind of lives we would lead.

I often think of one of my aunts who always found a way to meet each challenge without complaint. Her parenting often helped me to find a positive way to teach a lesson to my own children. I'm not saying my Mom was inadequate when I needed a better way to approach a parenting issue. However our own parents are sometimes too close to us. My aunt was my go to memory when I needed inspiration. If I had an example like Mister Rogers, it was my aunt.

As I face the new challenges that this year brings I am grateful that I could learn from my aunt's example. And I can remember the loving advice I got when I watched Mister Rogers with my two boys. Thank you, God, for these wonderful living examples of lives well lived.
