OUTREACH

THE ASSOCIATION OF FAITH COMMUNITIES (AFC)

Several years ago Resurrection joined with other faith communities in the county to form the AFC to address the needs of our sisters and brothers without homes. AFC currently runs three programs: the Faith Community Shelter—a nightly rotating shelter that provides a warm bed, a meal and support to those experiencing homelessness, Safe Spaces—a safe parking program that allows those sleeping in their vehicles a place to sleep soundly, and a mobile shower program that provides a hot shower to those living in camps and shelters. Resurrection has always been an active leadership partner in the AFC, and at last weekend's masses we heard from our new Faith Community Shelter Manager, Sam Altis. Sam shared with us about a unique opportunity to support AFC's work financially. Through the end of November, a generous donor is providing a 2:1 match for every dollar given to AFC. Your \$20 gift becomes \$60. Your \$100 gift becomes \$300.

FUNDS TO HOUSE THE HOMELESS AVAILABLE!

300 new housing vouchers available for those without homes, and our Association of Faith Communities (our shelter organization) is looking for rental units to house People currently in our shelter and Safe Spaces (parking) programs. If you have rental unit available, the AFC will refer our best candidates to you for consideration.

The County Housing Authority will pay the rent at market value, and is currently offering a \$2,000 bonus to most landlords who rent to individuals with a voucher. Also, Landlords can be reimbursed up to \$5000 for damages that exceed the security deposit, unpaid rent, vacancy loss or legal fees.

Landlords have the benefit of direct deposit, a landlord portal, a single point of contact- the Leasing Specialist, and the security of knowing that the rent will be paid, even if a tenants income decreases.

The properties eligible must not be a room in your house but an area with a separate entrance and bath/cooking areas. If you are interested in renting to an AFC shelter or safe spaces member, contact AFC shelter director Sam Altis at 831-515-6964

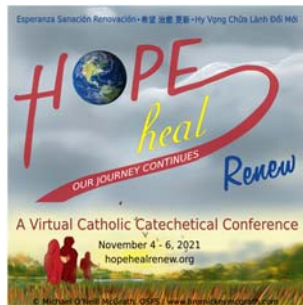

A Reflection by Erma Coty

I heard the song "Autumn Leaves" this weekend. It was part of a musical montage put on by the UOP Conservatory of Music. It was perfect for the moment since we could look around and enjoy the colorful leaves on the liquid amber trees against the grey skies that held the promise of rain. It is November, the month of contrasts during which we pick the last tomatoes from the garden and experience the first chill in the air. It is time to check the furnace and clean the rain gutters. Time to prepare for the coming winter.

There is no single plan for getting ready for the winter months. Country folks have different needs than city dwellers. Seasonal changes vary depending on where one lives. Some people who experience dramatic changes in weather may be packing up summer clothes and taking winter wardrobes out of storage. Does anyone besides me remember airing out winter jackets and sweaters that had been protected by mothballs for the summer months? Here, on the Central Coast, we just add and subtract layers to accommodate the changes in weather. Our warmer clothes may be at the bottom of the drawer or stuffed in the back of the closet. Or we may keep them at hand for evening walks on the beach.

As I get older, it is a challenge to remember what I need to do to get ready for cold weather. I don't always remember exactly where I put my gloves or favorite scarf. And, who hasn't found a 10 dollar bill or a missing rosary in the jacket pocket of a winter coat or sweater? This year, as I go through my routine to "winterize" my house, the landscaping, and the cars, I am creating a checklist so that in the coming years I will simply refer to my list of tasks to prepare for colder weather. An excellent plan!

I just have to remember where I keep the list. (Hint: keep a copy on the computer, on your fridge or bulletin board, and in your sock drawer.)

The internet has many resources that provide detailed suggestions for recommended tasks to prepare for winter. Remember to be careful if you are planning to clean your own gutters or check your roof for aging shingles. Allow yourself to ask for help from a family member or trusted handyman.

NOTE: We continue to need extra precautions related to the COVID virus. Many Hands can provide minimal services. Call or email if you need help finding help.
