Reflection by Erma Coty

Today, I am thankful for the TV channels that replay the same movies over and over and over. I shamelessly watch my favorites every chance I get. With COVID as a “go to” excuse, I easily rationalize my behavior. At least to myself. I know if I followed the example of one of the many saints I’ve read about, I would spend my time in prayer and service, perhaps while I scrubbed the floors and windows. But, no! I spend many hours watching Star Wars IV: A New Hope, Guardians of the Galaxy, and The Avengers. Yet I know that I will have to eventually return to some semblance of normal.

During the past 15 months we have been forced to adapt to a new way of doing things. We spent less time driving, and saved time by carefully planning shopping trips to limit potential exposure to a virus. My “to do” list got a bit shorter but by no means completed. Of course, this gave me more hours to enjoy Sunday afternoon with the Mandalorian and Baby Yoda, and visiting the Bridgerton family for a change of pace.

Now that the weather is warmer, I can open the windows or sit outside and watch the garden grow. In truth, some of my family did not really know how much I liked the fantasy/sci fi movie universe. And I didn’t know many of the things that my family members care about. We all gained a new appreciation of each other’s likes, dislikes, and responsibilities, both routine as well as those imposed on us by the pandemic. Hopefully we will return to more normal routines and still remember what we learned. I am thankful for this opportunity I have been given to empathize and appreciate that we all need to navigate our ordinary challenges the best we can.

We may still have a few months of semi hermit life ahead to get prepared for a full return to pre-pandemic lifestyles. The question then is: what do we want that to look like? Many of us have changed our routines and discovered (or re-discovered) that we are thankful for many lifestyle opportunities that we had not considered before. John Lennon’s words, “Life is what happens to you while you’re busy making other plans”, come to mind ... again.

So, I am thankful for the past year. I learned things I would never have learned, enjoyed my quiet moments, and I am unrepentant about the hours of time spent enjoying my favorite movies. Thank you, Lord!
