WELCOME BACK TO CHURCH INDOORS!

We have **two masses each weekend indoors:**
Saturday at 5:00 PM & Sunday at 10:15 AM.

Due to social distancing requirements we have limited seating, and reservations are required. **To reserve a seat for weekend masses please [click here](#).**

- **Please arrive at least 10 minutes early for screening. Surgical masks or 2-ply cloth masks with a bendable nose band are required for everyone. Two masks recommended. Contactless temperatures will be taken.**
- **If you are unvaccinated & have been exposed to someone with COVID you must quarantine for 10 days before coming to church.**
- **If you have been fully vaccinated and are exposed to a COVID-19 positive person you do not have to quarantine; however this only applies if no more than 3 months have elapsed since the date of your last (or single) shot.**
- **If you are unvaccinated you should quarantine for 10 days if you have traveled out of state, but it is not required. If you are vaccinated this is not necessary.**

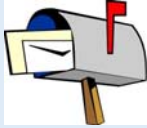

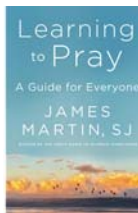

We are able to purchase what we need from the Food Bank at a fraction of retail cost thanks to your generous donations, and we receive many free things from the Food Bank as well. SHELTER PROGRAM: Our round-the-clock shelter relocated to the VFW Hall in Live Oak June 1st after 13 months here at Resurrection. It was sad to see them go! They have been a wonderful presence in Markey Center and in our lives. Over this time there have been two shelters operated by our Faith Communities Shelter, a program of the Association of Faith Communities (AFC), which Resurrection helped to start many years ago. The other shelter has been hosted by Santa Cruz Methodist Church. Both shelters are now combined at the VFW to simplify management and costs. Thank you for your prayers and support for this life-saving ministry! Here's a beautiful thank you poem written by one of the guests:

To Everyone at Resurrection Church:

We write this "Thank You" letter

*Because our lives got better
By you opening up your door
To the homeless and the poor.*

*We know we're not the best

Thanks to the stability provided by our round-the-clock shelter over the past 13 months, 40 of our guests have been able to work and save up enough money to move into their own homes.

“SAFE SPACES” PARKING HOSPITALITY Some people without homes live in their vehicles, whether they be cars or vans or RV's. Resurrection has joined with other faith communities and organizations in Santa Cruz County to provide safe and supervised overnight parking for some of these brother and sisters. The program is managed by the Association of Faith Communities, of which Resurrection is a founding member, and which also manages our shelter program. We currently have six guests staying in their RV's at night, safe and secure. We had electrical outlets installed in two of our lamp posts to provide power for our guests. A Reflection by Erma Coty

I think we all would benefit from a miracle about now. One of our parishioners was blessed by just such a miracle. I remember the wonderful old song "I Believe" that was popular when I was much younger. I could not help but recall the lyrics when this story was shared with me. If you want to stroll down memory lane, look up "I Believe" by Frankie Laine

In late October 2019, I was visiting my daughter when I became very ill. My daughter called 911 and the paramedics arrived quickly. After checking my vital signs they told me I was to go to the hospital. There the doctors ran some tests and decided they were not equipped to take care of me. They had found I had kidney failure, a kidney infection, a urinary infection and a sepsis infection. They said I was very critically ill and they were going to send me by helicopter as the new hospital in Modesto was 3 hrs. away by ambulance. As they were loading me into the helicopter one nurse whispered, to another nurse "I hope she doesn't die in the helicopter!"

The new doctors were waiting for me at the helicopter pad and said "We were waiting for you". One doctor patted my hand saying "we'll take care of you!" I was rushed to the ER and was there for ten days. I remember nothing about the ER. Then they felt I was stable enough and transferred me to the Transitional Unit. I was there for several days and then transferred to the regular ward where I was kept in bed for 30 days. They gradually let me up to walk a few steps but I found I didn't know how to walk! That called for Physical Therapy! I caught several viruses and was kept in Isolation for a long time. Then I came down with double pneumonia! They treated that and after ten days was back for Physical Therapy. I continued to be on antibiotics during this entire time and continued to be on it for ten days even in the hospital where I was transferred for more Physical Therapy.

All in all I was in the hospital for four months! As I was having my discharge checkup the Doctor asked me, "Did you thank the Holy Spirit for your recovery?" I mumbled, "I hadn't thought of it!" Well he said "You should! He was with us the entire time in the ER and without him you wouldn't be alive today. We couldn't have saved you without him!"

I certainly thanked the Holy Spirit then and have continued to do so, often several times day.

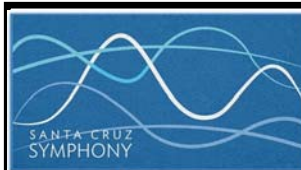
