## Reopening of California

### What do I need to know to attend mass?

- Reservations are no longer required to attend weekend masses.
- The dispensation from the Sunday Obligation will remain in place at this time. This is subject to change later this summer by Bishop Garcia.
- "For fully vaccinated individuals a face mask is not required. For unvaccinated individuals, a face mask is required indoors."
- You are welcome to continue wearing a mask if you are not comfortable going without.
- The daily mass chapel will be reserved for people who are wearing masks and are not comfortable being around unmasked people yet. Thank you for your cooperation.
- Social Distancing is no longer required.
- Singing is allowed.
- Hand sanitizing stations will remain. Entering and exiting the church will remain the same. We will no longer be taking temperatures.
- We will continue with daily mass being held in the main body of the church.
- Weekday Mass Schedule: Tuesday through Friday at **8:30 am** in person and live streamed. Holy Hour & Benediction on Fridays after mass.
- Weekend Mass Schedule: Saturday at 5:00 pm in person; Sunday at 10:15 am in person and live streamed.

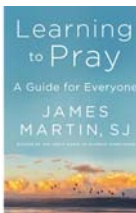

The program is managed by the Association of Faith Communities, of which Resurrection is a founding member, and which also manages our shelter program. We currently have six guests staying in their RV’s at night, safe and secure. We had electrical outlets installed in two of our lamp posts to provide power for our guests. Please keep them in your prayers!

**SHELTER PROGRAM:** Our round-the-clock shelter relocated to the VFW Hall in Live Oak June 1st after 13 months here at Resurrection. Thank you for your prayers and support for this life-saving ministry! Let us keep them in our prayers as they adjust to the new location. May they find permanent housing soon!

**Thanks to the stability provided by our round-the-clock shelter over the past 13 months, 40 of our guests have been able to work and save up enough money to move into their own homes.**

**A Reflection by Erma Coty**

Every once in a while, a forgotten memory is triggered by an unrelated event. I remember this happening when I was looking for plants at Orchard Supply one afternoon. It seemed as if the retrieved memory was running through my mind like an old film clip. I was compelled to pause and pay attention and remember. Some of the remembrance was sweet and some, not so much. But it came to me at an unexpected moment in time, perhaps reminding me of how a particular behavior affected me. In that case, a moment best not repeated.

I guess we are blessed to have a lifetime of memories that help to inform how we behave each day. A kind of experiential database responding to key words or environmental reminders. My sister got shocked plugging in a radio when we were small. Like Pavlov's rat, I learned from her experience. I was a precocious rat who learned by observing, no need to try the task myself. The problem with learning from other folk's experiences is that life can whisper by and you might miss out on the best parts in an effort to stay safe.

Over the last year, many of us were able to "stay safe" from the dread virus while learning to live a very different life than we were used to. It might be a good time to take inventory of our pandemic experience as we transition back to some of our former activities. To be honest, I have been muddling over the word "regret", wondering if I should have spent this time accomplishing more, using my time more effectively. How might I have better spent this year?

So, I looked for quotes about having regrets and realized (besides the fact that many of these quotes are attributed to more than one well known person) that I don't really regret most of my choices. In fact, given identical circumstances, I would likely not change much. Which is, of course different than believing that I could have accomplished more and made "better" use of my time. I think most of us would agree that the hours we spent not driving "here and there" were an unexpected gift. Or that the extra time we had with our spouse or children weren't blessings. On the other hand, time, both too much and too little, is the most difficult confounder in any equation.

Time is easy to use up and impossible to replace. It can feel like it passes too quickly or is relentlessly slow. No matter how much I use, there is likely more time left.

And if I am clever, I can move faster and accomplish more in less time leaving myself with extra time. Unlike other currency, time must be "spent" in the moment. Unlike sick time or vacation time, it can't be
