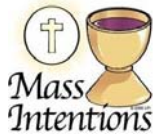

Senior Resource Ministry

A Reflection by Erma Coty

Remember when we were asked to write about what we did on our summer vacation? I could do that since I am now back to work but some vacations are better not shared. Not that it was bad or boring. Just the kind of vacation that needs the passage of time to be appreciated.

We are entering the second fall and winter of uncertainty. I had hoped that by now we would have learned how to successfully stay safe during the COVID pandemic. However, even with access to very effective vaccines and public health measures we are still struggling as many folks are unable, unwilling or just uncomfortable with the health recommendations. I find myself thinking about how those who lived in past times might have reacted to this dilemma.

When I was a child, we were blessed with Jonas Salk and the first vaccine for polio. In our town we lined up at John S. Park School to be vaccinated. We were eager to be allowed to return to the public pool, to gather at a circus or at a fair without fear of being exposed to polio. For those less fortunate, who were infected before the vaccine or did not have access to a vaccine clinic, Sister Kenny's therapy helped them to regain and maintain muscle strength.

Before that the world witnessed the medical miracle that provided for the prevention of smallpox. We remember the smallpox vaccine since it caused itching and scabbing and eventually left a small scar. Most children born in 1970 or later never had to have this vaccine as the disease had been eradicated.

Some pandemics, however just ran their course. The flu of 1918, the bubonic plague, and so many other diseases were managed primarily by quarantine. Hansen's Disease (leprosy) was treated by isolating sufferers of all ages in colonies, just as they had in Biblical times. The contributions of St. Father Damian of Molokai'i and the sisters who cared for children who had been separated from their families and sent to join the island colony are remarkable. Many of the children sent there for isolation remain even though they no longer suffer from the disease. It is the only home they know.

Jesus brought hope and healing to at least one "leper" who had faith in Him. I'm thinking that faith is what will give us patience as we deal with public health protocols. Faith will help us be aware of our responsibility to be our "brother's keeper", to wear a mask even though it is not always comfortable, and to do our part, as other generations have. We can do these small things with great love.
