

CARE FOR OUR COMMON HOME

It has been eight years since Pope Francis published his ground-breaking encyclical *Laudato Si – On Care for Our Common Home* (and he's working on a update of it). In it he laid out the moral imperative for all Catholics and for all of humanity to make changes in our lives to lessen the effects of our behavior on climate change, for the sake of the vulnerable now, and for the sake of generations to come. EQUINOX OR SOLSTICE


The Autumnal Equinox marks the transition from summer to fall and the Vernal Equinox, the change from winter to spring. I never really knew what the word equinox meant though the prefix “equi” implies equal and nox is Latin for night. The equinox occurs when the night and day hours are equal. Astronomers are able to mathematically compute the exact moment the equinox occurs.

Solstice, on the other hand, is a bit different. Winter solstice celebrates the shortest day, and longest night, of the year; summer solstice, the longest day and the shortest night. Again these moments are calculated exactly regardless of observance of daylight savings time.

The seasons are part of the spiritual base for many cultures; we plant, sow, harvest, and rest. Celtic mythology, the Druids and Stonehenge, the Arthurian tales, and the words of Ecclesiastes 3:1-8 remind us, “to everything there is a season”.

Before we knew the science of astronomy people of many cultures intertwined their spiritual beliefs with the changing of the seasons. Enjoy more information about the tradition surrounding the seasons by exploring the following links. Enjoy.
