## **THE SYNOD**

### **THE SYNOD – COMMUNION, PARTICIPATION,**

**MISSION:** On the Feast of Saint Francis of Assisi (October 4), Pope Francis convened the Universal Phase of the Synod on Synodality in Vatican City. The Synod process started in October of 2021 with the "listening" phase as Catholics around the world gathered in our parishes to reflect on the blessing of the Church in people's lives and on how the Church might be called to grow in service and mission. These reflections were summarized into a document that was studied and discussed in October at the Universal Synod in Rome by 294 bishops and 70 other women and men (lay people, clergy, and religious) appointed by Pope Francis from around the world.

**The Synod assembly has published a summary report of their discussions (read it [HERE](#)). They will reconvene next October to resume their discussions and to make recommendations for Pope Francis to consider.**

### **CARE FOR OUR COMMON HOME—LAUDATO DEUM**

Pope Francis recently published a follow-up to his ground-breaking 2015 encyclical *Laudato Si, Laudato Deum* "Praise God". (Read *Laudato Deum* [HERE](https://resurrection-aptos.org). It is located on our website <https://resurrection-aptos.org>, under Resource Center under Faith Formation.) In it Pope Francis reiterates the **moral imperative** for all Catholics and for all of humanity **to make changes** in our lives to lessen the effects of our behavior on climate change, for the sake of the vulnerable now, and for the sake of generations to come. We can all be more conscious of how our individual, daily choices either increase greenhouse gases or reduce them. This can all seem overwhelming and hopeless at times. What difference can I make? We need to work together to educate and encourage one another in the moral imperative to change our ways. Our longtime friends at Temple Beth El and other local faith communities have invited us to join with them in this work. As we have seen in our other collaborations with faith communities (AFC, COPA, Mid-County Homeless Coalition), when we join together with other people of faith and good will, good things happen!

We have a Zoom meeting each month and discuss how we can work together to make better choices and to advocate for better policies and practices in our region.

### **KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS COATS FOR KIDS DRIVE**

There are many local families struggling to clothe their children in warm winter jackets this year. For the past eight years, The Knights of Columbus from Resurrection Council, working in conjunction with Sister Rosa Dolores Rodriguez, founder of Casa de la Cultura in Pajaro, have provided new winter jackets each year for as many as 525 children, living far below the poverty level.

These jackets will be distributed to the children at the annual Christmas Party that Sister Rosa will hold for them and their families on December 18th. Even more of a demand exists for the families that were impacted by the devastating flood of the town of Pajaro back in March. For many of the children, the gift received at Sister Rosa's Christmas party is the only one they will get for Christmas.

Columbia Sportswear has made a wonderful assortment of new children's jackets available in all different styles, colors, and sizes for the Knights to purchase at 50% below their regular wholesale cost, at \$25-30 each, including freight. These same jackets sell in the stores for \$70-\$80.

This year, three Anonymous Donors have contributed \$9,000.00 in cash to the Knights with the understanding that it must be matched, or the money returned. We must not let that happen since Sister Rosa is counting on us.
