CARE FOR OUR COMMON HOME—LAUDATO DEUM

Pope Francis recently published a follow-up to his ground -breaking 2015 encyclical Laudato Si, Laudato Deum "Praise God". (Read Laudato Deum HERE. It is located on our website https://resurrection-aptos.org, under Resource Center under Faith Formation.) In it Pope Francis reiterates the moral imperative for all Catholics and for all of humanity to make changes in our lives to lessen the effects of our behavior on climate change, for the sake of the vulnerable now, and for the sake of generations to come. We can all be more conscious of how our individual, daily choices either increase greenhouse gases or reduce them. This can all seem overwhelming and hopeless at times. What difference can I make? We need to work together to educate and encourage one another in the moral imperative to change our ways. Our longtime friends at Temple Beth El and other local faith communities have invited us to join with them in this work. As we have seen in our other collaborations with faith communities (AFC, COPA, Mid-County Homeless Coalition), when we join together with other people of faith and good will, good things happen!

We have a Zoom meeting each month and discuss how we can work together to make better choices and to advocate for better policies and practices in our region.


