
SATURDAY MORNING MEDITA-TION GROUP

MARKEY COMMUNITY CENTER PROJECT UPDATE 11-01-24

After 4 1/2 years, the permit for our insurance claim for the February 2020 tree damage to Markey Community Center repairs has been granted! We are currently just waiting for the green light from insurance to begin.

In addition to repairing the actual damage to the hall, the county is also requiring that our building be brought up to current codes, including fire sprinklers, kitchen upgrades, ADA bathrooms, and ADA path-of-travel for the entire property.

The work will accomplish some of our original remodel project, which will be completed at a future date. (For insurance purposes, we had to separate the two projects so that all the work required to repair the damage and meet current building codes would be paid for with the insurance settlement.)

We are hoping that the work will begin soon. Once construction begins it will take at least a year. (If possible, we'd like to start the rest of our remodel project near the end of the repair project, so this may extend the overall work time.)

This, of course, will impact most of our ministries and activities, and we will gracefully adapt! Our Tuesday homeless shelter is being hosted by other churches in the AFC network and with meals are still provided by our parishioners. Our friends at St. John's Episcopal Church in Seacliff are hosting the shower ministry, still staffed by our volunteers.

Let us patiently endure this time of change with generosity, hope, and gratitude for a better, safer, and more accessible community center!

The Parish Assistance Ministry/Food Pantry will operate out of the small trailer on Mondays & Fridays from 10:00 am—12:00 noon.

THE ASSOCIATION OF FAITH COMMUNITIES (Santa Cruz) has been operating overnight shelter and shelter dinner programs at Resurrection since early 2016 to help people in need within our community. The ministry consists of 8 food teams. The teams rotate in numerical order, meaning that each team preps and serves a dinner for about 16-18 people once every other month. In general, the teams work out the specifics on a rotating basis: 1 or 2 people bring the main dish, 1 person brings salad, 1 person brings veggie or another side dish, 1 person brings dessert, 1 person brings drinks and a breakfast snack or some variation of this schedule. We are currently looking for additional volunteers to support this ministry. We encourage all volunteers to stay and share the meal with our shelter guests. The shelter will be located at various churches within the area due to construction at Resurrection. 

Fr. Mike served as our pastor here at Resurrection from 1978-1985.



KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS COATS FOR KIDS PROGRAM APPEAL

THE WEEKEND, NOVEMBER 9th and 10th:

There are many local families struggling to clothe their children in warm winter jackets this year. For the past nine years, The Knights of Columbus from Resurrection Council, working in conjunction with Sister Rosa Dolores Rodriquez, founder of Casa de la Cultura in Pajaro, have provided new winter jackets each year for as many as 560 children, living far below the poverty level. You will have the opportunity to meet Sr. Rosa at the 10:15 AM Mass on November 10th.

These jackets will be distributed to the children at the annual Christmas Party that Sister Rosa will hold for them and their families on December 23th. Sister Rosa is begging for these jackets, as the need is even more critical than the last few years, when the Knights helped her with them. Even more of a demand exists for the families that were impacted by the devastating flood of the town of Pajaro. For many of the children, the gift received at Sister Rosa's Christmas party is the only one they will get for Christmas. Many of the parents were out of work due to COVID-19 and the floods, so Christmas won't happen unless we help Sister Rosa make it happen for those children.

Columbia Sportswear has made a wonderful assortment of new children's jackets available in all different styles, colors, and sizes for the Knights to purchase at 50% below their regular wholesale cost, at \$25-30 each, including freight. These same jackets sell in the stores for \$80-\$90.

This year, so far, two Anonymous Donors have contributed \$6,000.00 in cash to the Knights with the understanding that it must be matched, or the money returned. We must not let that happen since Sister Rosa is counting on us.
