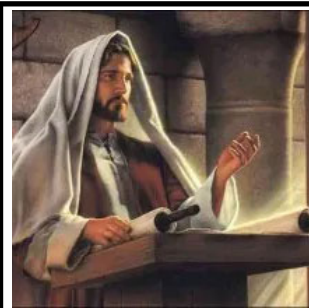

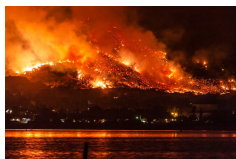

MARKEY COMMUNITY CENTER PROJECT UPDATE

After nearly 5 years, the permit for our insurance claim for
the February 2020 tree damage to Markey Community
Center repairs has been granted! We are currently just
waiting for the green light from insurance to begin. Please
pray that this happens soon!

In addition to repairing the actual damage to the hall, the
county is also requiring that our building be brought up to
current codes, including fire sprinklers, kitchen upgrades,
ADA bathrooms, and ADA path-of-travel for the entire
property.

The work will accomplish some of our original remodel pro-
ject, which will be completed at a future date. (For insur-
ance purposes, we had to separate the two projects so that
all the work required to repair the damage and meet cur-
rent building codes would be paid for with the insurance
settlement.)



Once construction begins it will take at least a year. (If
possible, we'd like to start the rest of our remodel project
near the end of the repair project, so this may extend the
overall work time.)


Let us patiently endure this time of change with generosity,
hope, and gratitude for a better, safer, and more accessible
community center!
