THE MASS NEVER ENDS—IT MUST BE LIVED! (Reflection questions for 5:00pm & 8:15am masses) We are invited to continue to reflect upon the Gospel reading (Luke 13:1-9) and homily as we live out our Eucharist this week. Reflect upon it in your heart and mind, and discuss it with your family, friends and faith community members.

- How have you been nurtured and fed in your physical and spiritual life? How has this nurturing borne fruit?
- Are you ever tempted to give up on someone because they never seem to come through? How does today's parable speak to this attitude?
- Once again, Jesus points us away from thinking about other people's sins and calls us to be aware of our own need for repentance. In what way do you need to repent?

(Reflection questions for 10:15am mass)

We are invited to continue to reflect upon the Gospel reading (John 4:5-42) and homily as we live out our Eucharist this week. Reflect upon it in your heart and mind, and discuss it with your family, friends and faith community members.

 Jesus disregarded the religious and cultural barriers that divided Jews and Samaritans in order to reach out to the woman. Have you ever had to do that to help someone or to do what was right?

- How do you experience "thirst" or deep longing in your life? How might Jesus satisfy that thirst?
- Jesus accepted the woman in spite of her sins and failures. How have you experienced Jesus doing this for you?

RULES OF FAST & ABSTINENCE



All Fridays in Lent and Good Friday are days of abstinence from meat for everyone age 14 & older. Good Friday is also a day of fasting (one full meal, two smaller meals, and nothing in between for those from their ABSTINENCE 21st birthday to the day after their 59th birthday) That is the letter of the law, but the

spirit of the law is to make a real sacrifice in union with Jesus who sacrificed himself to save us.







