THE MASS NEVER ENDS—IT MUST BE LIVED! (Reflection questions for 5:00pm & 8:15am masses)

We are invited to continue to reflect upon the Gospel reading (Luke 15:1-3, 11-32) and homily as we live out our Eucharist this week. Reflect upon it in your heart and mind, and discuss it with your family, friends and faith community members.

- Have you ever felt that someone would never forgive you for something you did or said, but they did anyway?
- What is the most powerful experience of being forgiven that you have ever had?
- Have you ever resented a “Johnny-come-lately” when you have worked long, hard and faithfully for something?

- Jesus asks, “Do you believe in the Son of Man?” Do you? How do you deal with the fact that many people you know don’t believe in him or in his divine uniqueness in human history?

All Fridays in Lent and Good Friday are days of abstinence from meat for everyone age 14 & older. Good Friday is also a day of fasting (one full meal, two smaller meals, and nothing in between for those from their 21st birthday to the day after their 59th birthday) That

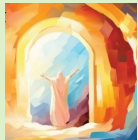

News from the Diocese of Monterey's Vocation Office:

Seminarian Jaime Guerra Installation to the Ministry of Acolyte: On March 8, 2025 Seminarian Jaime received the ministry of acolyte. This event is the very last stage of a man's priestly formation, right before diaconate and presbyterate. In a nutshell, "Acolyte" derives from a Greek term, akolouthos, which means "server," "companion," or "follower." In the Roman Catholic Church, a person is installed in the ministry of Acolyte in order to assist the deacon and the priest in liturgical celebrations, especially the Eucharistic Liturgy. Besides the deacon and the priest, the acolyte is the one closest to the altar. To be instituted as an Acolyte, a seminarian first has to be a candidate and a lector, which means he has to be in formation at least five years. This tradition indicates the significance of the Acolyte's ministry, which is linked closely to the sacred ministry of the priesthood.

The acolyte plays an essential role in the celebration of the Holy Mass. The General Instructions of the Roman Missal clearly indicates his duties (no. 178-193). Two of them are of special significance: setting up the altar and distributing Holy Communion. Let us continue to pray for Sem. Jaime as he moves forward in his seminary formation!
