- Ash Wednesday: March 5 Masses at 8:30 am & 7:00 pm. (Evening mass will be live-streamed).
- Stations of the Cross: The Fridays of Lent: March 7 April 11 at 12:15 pm in the church in person. We have a Stations on our YouTube channel that you can view at anytime
- Weekday Mass (Tuesday—Friday) at 8:30 am
- Monday Morning Prayer (on demand) on our You Tube Channel (link on our website)
- Night Prayer (on demand) on our You Tube Channel (link on our website)
- Rule of Fast & Abstinence: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting (one full meal, two smaller meals, and nothing in between for those from their 21st birthday to the day after their 59th birthday) and abstinence (no meat for everyone age 14 & older). All Fridays in Lent and Good Friday are days of abstinence from meat. That is the letter of the law, but the spirit of the law is to make a real sacrifice in union with Jesus who sacrificed himself to save us.
- Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confessions): During Lent we have several opportunities to celebrate this Sacrament. We will have a Reconciliation Service on Wednesday, April 9. Individual confessions will also be heard during our Holy Hour on the Fridays of Lent between 9:00 am—10:00 am. If these times don't fit into your schedule please contact the parish office to set up an appointment with Fr. Romeo.
