

All Fridays in Lent and Good Friday are days of abstinence from meat for everyone age 14 & older. Good Friday is also a day of fasting (one full meal, two smaller meals, and nothing in between for those from their 21st birth-ABSTINENCE day to the day after their 59th birthday) That is the letter of the law, but the spirit of the

law is to make a real sacrifice in union with Jesus who sacrificed himself to save us.






