

### THE MASS NEVER ENDS—IT MUST BE LIVED!

We are invited to continue to reflect upon the Gospel reading (John 13:31-35) and homily as we live out our Eucharist this week. Reflect upon it in your heart and mind, and discuss it with your family, friends and faith community members.

- Think of a time when you were impressed by how people really loved one another. How could you tell that they loved one another? How did that encounter make you feel about yourself and your own life and relationships?
- Jesus basically seems to be saying that true Christianity and all its moral and theological precepts boil down to this: that we really love one another as Jesus has loved us. Our "practice of the faith" is really about our relationships with other people – do we love them as Jesus loves us? Jesus calls this "a new commandment." Is this perspective on our practice of religion new to you? Is following this "new commandment" your primary focus as you set out to live each day and your standard of evaluating the successes and failures of each day lived? How would your life be different if it were?
- There are many things that go by the name of "love," but in this gospel Jesus is defining love as how he has loved us. If we want to know what real love is, we have to see and experience how Jesus loves us. How has Jesus loved you? Based on this love of Jesus, what is love?



## **IDAHO MISSION TRIP** June 8—16, 2025

This year, 19 of our teens, young adults, and chaperones will be heading to Lapwai, Idaho for an annual mission trip. This will be the thirteenth year that Deborah & Hal Rovick have led our youth and made the journey via car, train, and van to help serve the Nez Perce Tribe. Over the years they have developed a relationship of trust with the native people. Our youth will be working on several projects this year. In the past, we have constructed handicap ramps for the elders of the tribe, rebuilt the Trading Post, assembled a play structure, painted homes, replaced floors and built and raised 2 shade/weather structures.

How can you help? You can participate in our trip in several ways, without leaving home!

- You can pray for the group and the people of the • Nez Perce Tribe. Each workday at noon the group will be praying The Angelus.
- You can participate in our fundraiser after the masses on May 17 & 18, by leaving a donation and putting your name on a rock or a nail, which will be used in the projects that we will work on during our mission trip.
