After buying a house and learning of this pregnancy, she lost her job. She is in need of everything: diapers, wipes, onesies, socks, blankets, car seat, stroller, etc. She does not know the child's gender. She and her husband would be extremely appreciative for anything we can do to help them bridge this most difficult period on unemployment, a hefty new house payment, and an unexpected pregnancy. "Elizabeth" learned of the Gabriel Project through social media regarding women considering abortion. She is most thankful for those of you who have and continue to pray for life. Our prayers do, and specifically did make a difference here. Thank you and please continue to pray for people who consider abortion a "viable" option. Help them to look forward to their next steps: continuing in their education or entering the work world. Particularly help those who are seeking employment to find a job suitable to their education.

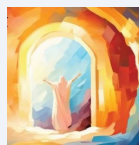
Give them faith and a sense of purpose in their next steps.

## IDAHO MISSION TRIP June 8—16, 2025

This year, 19 of our teens, young adults, and chaperones will be heading to Lapwai, Idaho for an annual mission trip. This will be the thirteenth year that Deborah & Hal Rovick have led our youth and made the journey via car, train, and van to help serve the Nez Perce Tribe. Over the years they have developed a relationship of trust with the native people. Our youth will be working on several projects this year. In the past, we have constructed handicap ramps for the elders of the tribe, rebuilt the Trading Post, assembled a play structure, painted homes, replaced floors and built and raised 2 shade/weather structures.

### How can you help? You can participate in our trip in several ways, without leaving home!

- You can pray for the group and the people of the Nez Perce Tribe. Each workday at noon the group will be praying The Angelus.
- **You can participate in our fundraiser**, by leaving a donation and putting your name on a rock or a nail, which will be used in the projects that we will work on during our mission trip. **Rocks & nails are available in the office.**

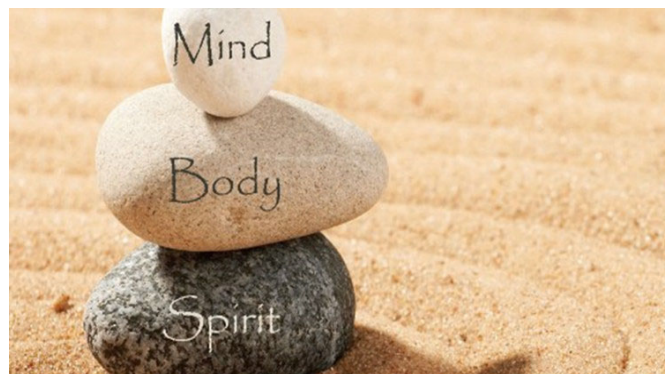
