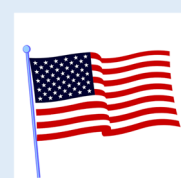

The Parish Office will be closed on Friday, July 4 in observance of Independence Day.

PARISH ASSISTANCE MINISTRY (PAM): Our second collection this weekend, June 28 & 29 is for the **Parish Assistance Ministry**, which provides money for rent, utilities, bus passes, and various other needs. Over the past 3 months (April, May and June to date) we have helped the community with 306 bags of food, 39 bus passes (\$187.20) and 14 monetary assistance applications totaling \$17,590, which covered rent assistance/emergency lodging, utilities, car repairs). Then the righteous will answer him and say "Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, and thirsty and give you drink. When did we see you a stranger and welcomed you, or naked and clothe you? 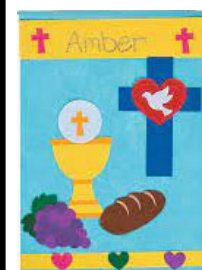

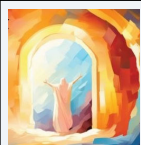

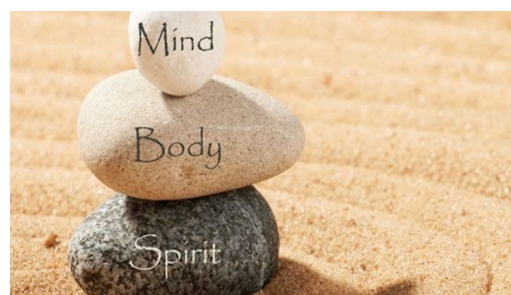
