CURSILLO IN CHRISTIANITY, a path to grow closer to



God Cursillo is a Roman Catholic movement founded in 1944 on the Spanish island of Majorca as a short course in Christianity. The Cursillo founder, Eduardo Bonnín Aguiló, is now on the first steps to beatification and canonization.

Cursillo was created to prepare men for the Camino de Santiago, a pilgrimage to the grave of St. James the Apostle. It was also intended to bring men back to church. The three-day short course in Christianity was so successful that the women asked to attend. Cursillo came to Texas in 1947 and to California in 1957. Cursillo was declared a *charism of the Holy Spirit* by the Catholic Church. It has been in the Monterey Diocese, since 1962.

WHAT IS A CURSILLO?

- It begins with a three-day retreat-like experience teaching basic life principals with a series of short talks by both lay people and a priest or deacon as the spiritual director for the weekend.
- The three pillars of Cursillo are Piety, Study and Action.
- Cursillo is intended to strengthen your Catholic faith; to experience the love of God; and to develop a deeper relationship with God and His Church.
- Participants arrive on Thursday and the Cursillo starts that evening and ends Sunday afternoon.
- Men attend the weekend first, while the women attend the following weekend.
- There is a kitchen team that focuses on great food and snacks for both the team and candidates. (Cost: \$200)

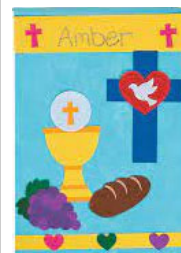

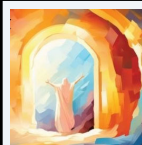

SAINTS OF THE WEEK

July 5: St. Anthony Mary Zaccaria, Priest. Born in Italy in 1502, Anthony became a medical doctor at age 22, then a priest at age 26. Anthony worked to reform both Church and society through his humility, asceticism, preaching and development of lay spirituality. He died at age 36.

July 6: St. Maria Goretti, Virgin & Martyr. Maria was born in 1890, daughter of a poor Italian tenant farmer. She had no opportunity for education, but was allowed to make her First Eucharist at age 12. Shortly thereafter, she was attacked by a neighbor, 18-year-old Alessandro Serenelli, who tried to rape her. Maria struggled and said she would rather die than submit to such evil. Alessandro struck her many times with a long dagger. Maria lived about 24 hours, during which she forgave Alessandro. He was sentenced to 30 years in prison and was unrepentant until one night he had a dream of



Maria offering him flowers. His heart changed and he asked for forgiveness. He was released after 27 years, and went immediately to ask Maria's mother for forgiveness. When Maria was canonized in 1950, Alessandro gathered with the pope and 250,000 other pilgrims in St. Peter's square, knelt, and cried tears of joy.

July 11: St. Benedict, Abbot. Born in Italy around 480, Benedict studied at Rome and was drawn to the contemplative life. As others came to learn the spiritual path from him, Benedict was inspired to form communities of contemplatives—monasteries. He founded Monte Cassino monastery and developed his famous Rule, which continues to be the foundation of Western monasticism to this day.

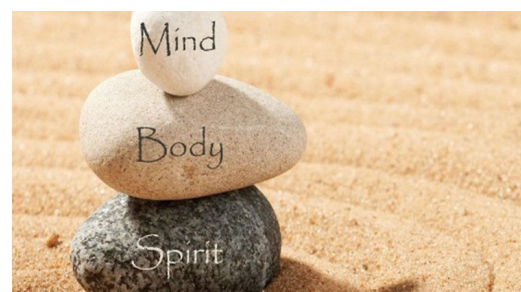
