# TWO PROJECTS IN ONE: The Insurance Project & the Parish Project:

The insurance project (tree damage repair and required

building code upgrades) & the parish project (complete roof replacement, parking lot repaving, exterior stucco "facelift" and interior expansion/remodeling) are being done concurrently. The insurance project will be funded by the insurance company and the parish project will be funded by our Markey Center building project capital campaign



that was started back in 2019. The pandemic and insurance company negotiations have delayed the project by six years and, of course, building costs have risen. We still need funds to complete all the necessary elements of the parish project, and it will less expensive to do them all now while we have the contractors on site than to put them off to the future. Almost all of the pledges from the 2019 capital campaign have been paid off, and we are grateful for everyone's generosity and faith. # CURSILLO IN CHRISTIANITY, a path to grow closer to



God Cursillo is a Roman Catholic movement founded in 1944 on the Spanish island of Majorca as a short course in Christianity. The Cursillo founder, Edwardo Bonnin Aguiló, is now on the first steps to beatification and canonization.

Cursillo was created to prepare men for the Camino de Santiago, a pilgrimage to the grave of St. James the Apostle. It was also intended to bring men back to church. The three-day short course in Christianity was so successful that the women asked to attend. Cursillo came to Texas in 1947 and to California in 1957. Cursillo was declared a *charism of the Holy Spirit* by the Catholic Church. It has been in the Monterey Diocese, since 1962.

#### WHAT IS A CURSILLO?

- It begins with a three-day retreat-like experience teaching basic life principals with a series of short talks by both lay people and a priest or deacon as the spiritual director for the weekend.
- The three pillars of Cursillo are Piety, Study and Action.
- Cursillo is intended to strengthen your Catholic faith; to experience the love of God; and to develop a deeper relationship with God and His Church.
- Participants arrive on Thursday and the Cursillo starts that evening and ends Sunday afternoon.
- Men attend the weekend first, while the women attend the following weekend.
- There is a kitchen team that focuses on great food and snacks for both the team and candidates. (Cost: \$200)

Dear Priests, Deacons, Consecrated Men and Women, Co-workers, Colleagues in Ministry, and Lay Faithful of the Diocese of Monterey:

Today, July 2, 2025, at 12 noon in Rome, it was announced that Pope Leo XIV has appointed me as Bishop of Austin, Texas. The Diocese of Austin has been without a Bishop since late March 2025.

The news of this appointment comes as a big surprise to me. Many of you know that the Diocese of Austin was the local Church that I was ordained for as a priest on May 28, 1988. I served there until I was appointed to serve in the Diocese of Monterey, as your Bishop on January 29, 2019.

To say that I have fallen in love with the Diocese of Monterey and all of you is a profound understatement. I always thought that I would remain either here or along the West Coast until retirement. At this time, I do not know the exact date when I will be leaving. This is still to be determined with the Apostolic Nuncio, but the initial conversation leans towards a September transition.

As soon as I find out more concrete information, I will let you know. I ask for your prayers as I begin to make this transition in my life and for the Diocese of Monterey. Be assured of my prayers for you.

Decir que me he enamorado de la Diócesis de Monterey y de todos ustedes es quedarse muy corto. Siempre pensé que me quedaría aquí o en la Costa Oeste hasta mi jubilación. Actualmente, desconozco la fecha exacta de mi partida. Esto aún está por ser determinado con el Nuncio Apostólico, pero las conversaciones iniciales apuntan a una transición en el mes de septiembre.

En cuanto tenga información más concreta, se los haré saber. Les pido sus oraciones mientras comienzo esta transición en mi vida y para la Diócesis de Monterey. Les aseguro que les tendré en mis oraciones por todos ustedes.
