## **UPCOMING EVENTS**

**SECOND COLLECTION FOR THE GAZA CRISIS:** Bishop Daniel Garcia along with the Archbishop Timothy

Broglio, President of the USCCB has requested that we take up a collection to help our brothers & sisters who are suffering in the Gaza Strip. From Bishop Broglio: Our Church mourns the terrible suffering of Christians and other innocent victims of violence in Gaza and surround-

ing areas who are struggling to survive,



protect their children, and live with dignity in dire conditions. The Holy Father continues to call for a cease fire and for aid to enter the territory, noting with great sorrow that "Gaza is starving." The Catholic Near East Welfare Association (CNEWA) is there providing vital emergency humanitarian relief and medical and psychological care for the sick, malnourished and wounded. Catholic Relief Services (CRS) is working through local Church partners to provide food, shelter, cash assistance, hygiene supplies, and care for people's emotional well-being. We will be taking up a collection this weekend, August 16 & 17, which will be used to provide humanitarian relief and pastoral support for our affected brothers and sisters in Gaza and surrounding areas in the Middle East. Both organizations have well-established partnerships with the Catholic Church in the region which allow them to respond quickly and efficiently. The situation in Gaza and across the Middle East cries out for the assistance of the Catholic community of the United States. We will send one check to the Diocese of Monterey and they will distribute the funds to CNEWA & CRS. Also please pray for the safe release of the remaining 24 hostages kidnapped by Hamas. ## MARKEY COMMUNITY CENTER BUILDING PROJECT

## TWO PROJECTS IN ONE:

The Insurance Project & the Parish Project: The insurance project (tree damage repair and required building code upgrades) & the parish project (complete roof replacement, parking lot repaving, exterior stucco "facelift" and interior expansion/remodeling) are being done concurrently. The insurance project will be funded by the insurance company and the parish project will be funded by

our Markey Center building project capital campaign that was started back in 2019. The pandemic and insurance company negotiations have delayed the project by six years and, of course, building costs have risen. We still need funds to complete all the necessary elements of the parish project, and it will less expensive to do them all now while we have the contractors on site than to put them off to the future. Almost all of the pledges from the 2019 capital campaign have been paid off, and we are grateful for everyone's generosity and faith. If you haven't given to the campaign or would like to make a new gift, that will help us to complete the parish project in the most efficient way. For those who prefer to give in person, you can still do so by donating with cash or checks dropped in the collection or mailed to the parish office.




