## UPCOMING EVENTS

**PARISH ASSISTANCE MINISTRY (PAM):** Our second collection next weekend, August 30 & 31 is for the **Parish Assistance Ministry**, which provides money for rent, utilities, bus passes, and various other needs. Over the past 3 months (June, July, August to date) we have helped the community with 289 bags of food, 40 bus passes (\$192.00) and 9 monetary assistance applications totaling \$12,519, which covered rent assistance, utilities, car repairs). ## MARKEY COMMUNITY CENTER BUILDING PROJECT

### **TWO PROJECTS IN ONE:**

#### **The Insurance Project & the Parish Project:**

The insurance project (tree damage repair and required building code upgrades) & the parish project (complete roof replacement, parking lot repaving, exterior stucco "facelift" and interior expansion/remodeling) are being done concurrently. The insurance project will be funded by the insurance company and the parish project will be funded by our Markey Center building project capital campaign that was started back in 2019. The pandemic and insurance company negotiations have delayed the project by six years and, of course, building costs have risen. We still need funds to complete all the necessary elements of the parish project, and it will less expensive to do them all now while we have the contractors on site than to put them off to the future. Almost all of the pledges from the 2019 capital campaign have been paid off, and we are grateful for everyone's generosity and faith. If you haven't given to the campaign or would like to make a new gift, that will help us to complete the parish project in the most efficient way. 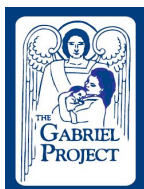

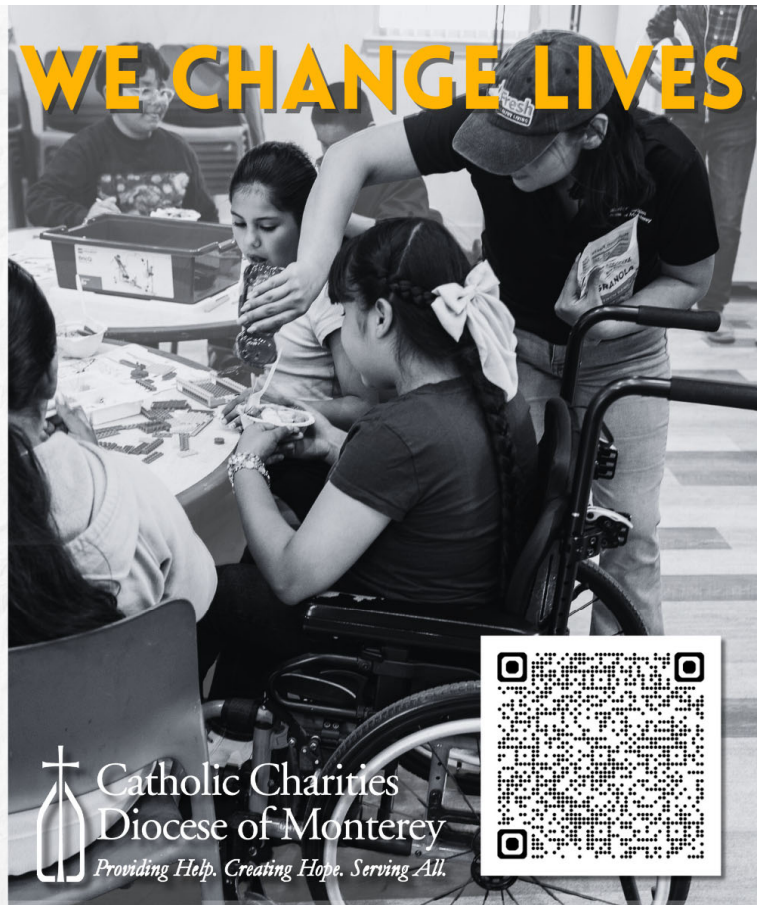
