
accessible path open to the church until the accessible area (cemetery pathway & sidewalk) in the cemetery parking lot is complete. Right now the cemetery parking lot is closed.



Dear Friends:

I'd like to give you an update on our Markey Community Center Repair/Remodel project!

The repair project, triggered by the February 2020 tree damage, includes building code upgrades such as new ADA restrooms, fire sprinklers, kitchen upgrades, partial roof replacement, and new sidewalks/paths of travel.

The remodel project includes: replacing the rest of the roof, new meeting rooms/classrooms and offices, new storage areas, solar panels, new lighting, and new room partitions.

We have a great team working on this project: our architect (Brett Brenkwitz), general contractor (Bogard Construction), and volunteer project manager (Mark Corley – the general contractor who built the church). This team meets with me, Deacon Patrick Conway, and Karen Victorino each week to keep us apprised of the progress and to get our input.

Since we started our remodel fundraising six years ago, the price of construction has risen, along with everything else. Fortunately, the falling of the trees on Markey Center has meant that many of the code upgrades that we would have had to pay for are now being covered by the insurance claim, which is about \$4.4 million. The remaining remodel project estimate is about \$3 million. So, we'll be getting \$7.4 million worth of project for about \$3 million!

We originally raised \$1.1 million in gifts and pledges for the remodel project. Some of these funds went towards pre-construction expenses (architectural and engineering fees, government fees & permits) and the balance will be used for the remodel project. The remaining \$2 million or so needed for the remodel project will come from some of our share of the sale of Good Shepherd School, which closed a few years ago and was owned by Resurrection, St. Joseph's and Our Lady Star of the Sea parishes. We received one-third of the proceeds (around \$3 million).

Our Finance Council, in consultation with the Diocese of Monterey, has chosen to do the following with these proceeds:

• \$500,000.00 will be put into the Bishop Harry Clinch Endowment Fund for the restricted benefit of tuition assistance for students attending the four Catholic Schools in Santa Cruz County (Holy Cross, Salesian Elementary & Junior High, Moreland Notre Dame & St. Francis High).

• \$500,000.00 will be placed in the Bishop Harry Clinch Endowment Fund for the benefit of Resurrection Church, pending the final cost of the Markey Center remodel project.

This will ensure a steady stream of funds not only for the scholarship fund for the Santa Cruz County Catholic Schools but our parish as well. By giving to the scholarship fund we are continuing the vision of Fr. Francis Markey to provide for Catholic education. And by giving to our own endowment fund we are providing a stronger financial future for our parish.

• The remaining \$2 million will be used to fund the Markey Center remodel. Based on our budget and the interest that we will accumulate before we actually have to draw down on these funds, we anticipate that we will have about \$3 million. This may not be enough to cover non-construction expenses, such as new tables & chairs, new burglar and phone systems, resurfacing both parking lots, and a security fence behind the hall – just to name just a few.


