Please join us on November 12 at 7pm at Resurrection Church (7600 Soquel Drive, Aptos) for an evening of inspiration and hope with prominent leaders of peace Aziz Abu Sarah and Maoz Inon. Maoz Inon is an Israeli entrepreneur and peace activist whose parents were tragically killed on October 7th. Aziz Abu Sarah is a Palestinian American author, National Geographic Explorer and peacebuilder from Jerusalem, whose brother was killed by Israeli soldiers. Despite their deeply personal experiences with loss stemming from the Israeli-Palestinian conflict, both men are unwavering proponents of peace and reconciliation.

Their <u>TED Talk</u> was the third most watched last year and they have given talks across the globe addressing members of the European Parliament, numerous university faculty and students, synagogues and members of congress. They were invited by the late Pope Francis to a Peace Event in Italy in 2024 and most recently met at the Vatican with Pope Leo.




"How can we forget the courageous embrace between Maoz Inon, an Israeli whose parents were killed by Hamas, and Aziz Abu Sarah, a Palestinian whose brother was killed by the Israeli army. They are now friends and work with one another. That gesture remains as a testimony and sign of hope" - Pope Leo XIV, Vatican, May 2025

Their personal narratives are incredibly powerful, offering a unique and deeply human perspective on the conflict that transcends political rhetoric. They embody the possibility of empathy and connection even in the face of immense suffering, and their message of forgiveness and hope is truly inspiring.
