THE MASS NEVER ENDS—IT MUST BE LIVED!

We are invited to continue to reflect upon the Gospel reading (Matthew 3:1-12) and homily as we live out our Eucharist this week. Reflect upon it in your heart and mind, and discuss it with your family, friends and faith community members.

- John issues a call for repentance I the strongest terms. What comes to your mind when you hear his words?
- John warns his fellow Jews that it is not enough to be children of Abraham, but that they must "produce good fruit as evidence of repentance." You became a child of God through baptism, but how do you think and act like one of God's children in your daily life? What is the evidence?
- John says that Jesus will baptize us with the Holy Spirit so that we can truly live as sons and daughters of God. We believe that Jesus gives us the Holy Spirit at baptism and renews this gift at other times in our lives. How have you been led toward what is good and right?
- As the readings suggest, the point of Advent is to help us prepare for the Second Coming of Christ.
 What do you think you need to do today and in the coming weeks to be ready?


