

The main parking lot is open. Please note that part of the lot is still blocked in front of the hall for construction. Be careful driving through the parking lot.





IF YOU ARE HOSPITALIZED OR HOMEBOUND:


If you or a member of your family are hospitalized or homebound, please call to let us know. We want to visit

Pastoral Message to the Faithful on the Appointment of Our New Bishop

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I write to you with gratitude to God to share important news in the life of our diocesan Church.

On December 17, 2025, the Holy Father appointed Bishop Ramón Bejarano, currently serving as Auxiliary Bishop of the Diocese of San Diego, as the next bishop of the Diocese of Monterey. We receive this announcement with joy, grateful for the Lord's providential care for His people and the guidance of the Holy Spirit, who continues to sustain the Church in every age.

The appointment of a bishop is a significant moment for a local Church. As a successor of the Apostles, the bishop is entrusted with the ministry of teaching, sanctifying, and governing the People of God in the name of Christ, the Good Shepherd. As we prepare to welcome Bishop Bejarano, we are invited to renew our commitment to prayer, unity, and faithful discipleship.

I ask all the faithful of the Diocese of Monterey—priests, deacons, consecrated religious, and lay faithful—to join me in praying for Bishop Bejarano as he prepares to assume this new pastoral responsibility. May the Lord grant him wisdom, humility, and pastoral charity, and may the Blessed Virgin Mary and all the saints intercede for him as he prepares to serve our diocesan family.

I am grateful for the opportunity to serve the Diocese of Monterey during this time as Apostolic Administrator, and I thank the clergy, religious, and lay faithful for your prayerful support and faithful witness. I also give thanks for the continued pastoral care of the Holy Father, who, in appointing our new bishop, provides for the needs of the Church entrusted to him.

Details regarding Bishop Bejarano's installation will be shared once arrangements have been finalized. Until then, let us continue to walk together in faith, confident that the Lord remains ever present to His Church.



Established in 1966 as a mission of St. Joseph's of Capitola, Resurrection officially became its own parish in the Diocese of Monterey in 1968.
