SAINTS OF THE WEEK

January 13: St. Hilary of Poitiers, Bishop & Doctor. He lived in the Church's early days (315-367) and is known as "defender of the divinity of Christ." It was through the study of the Christian Scriptures that Hilary was converted from paganism and baptized. Though married, he was elected Bishop of Poitiers (France) around 350 and spent the rest of his life teaching against Arianism, the heresy that denied the divinity of Christ. This heresy was tearing the Church apart at this time, and Hilary himself suffered exile for many years because of his staunch defense of Catholic belief. In one of his sermons Hilary prayed, "Impart to us the meaning of the words of Scripture and the light to understand it, with reverence for the doctrine and confidence in its truth. Grant that we may express what we believe."

January 17: St Anthony, Abbot. Anthony was born in Egypt in 251 and is honored as the founder of Christian monasticism. At age 20 he felt called to take literally Christ's gospel call to sell what he had and give it to the poor. For the next 85 years he lived an austere, ascetical life, devoting himself to prayer and the reading of scriptures. He supported himself through manual labor, and gave generously to the poor. Though he preferred solitude, Anthony took time to give spiritual direction and instruction to those who came to join him in the desert. He organized them into communities, laying the foundation for Christian monasticism. St. Athanasius, a bishop who knew Anthony well, wrote his biography and said, "Seeing the kind of life he lived, the villagers and all the good men he knew called him the friend of God, and loved him as both son and brother."

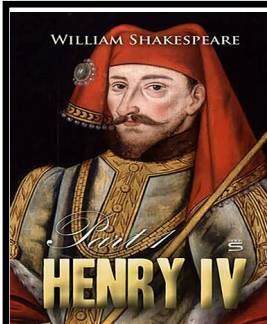
