THE MASS NEVER ENDS—IT MUST BE LIVED!

We are invited to continue to reflect upon the Gospel reading (Matthew 26:14-27, 66) and homily as we live out our Eucharist this week. Reflect upon it in your heart and mind, and discuss it with your family, friends and faith community members.

- We also call this “Palm” Sunday because of how Jesus was greeted upon his entrance into Jerusalem. Yet the same crowd that acclaimed him was the same crowd that rejected him on Good Friday. Is your own public acclamation of Jesus consistent, or do you sometimes waver or even feel hostility toward him?
- Most of all, this is called “Passion” Sunday because we remember the suffering and death of Jesus. Jesus was most passionate about our salvation, pouring out his very life’s blood in love for us. What are you most passionate about?
- As Jesus died and was laid in the tomb, the disciples must have felt confused and abandoned by Jesus, their faith nearly shattered. Have you ever felt that way?


