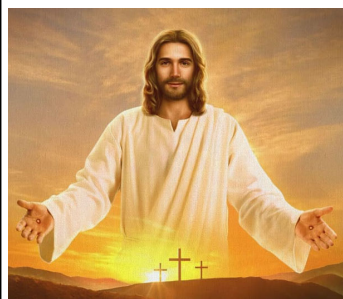

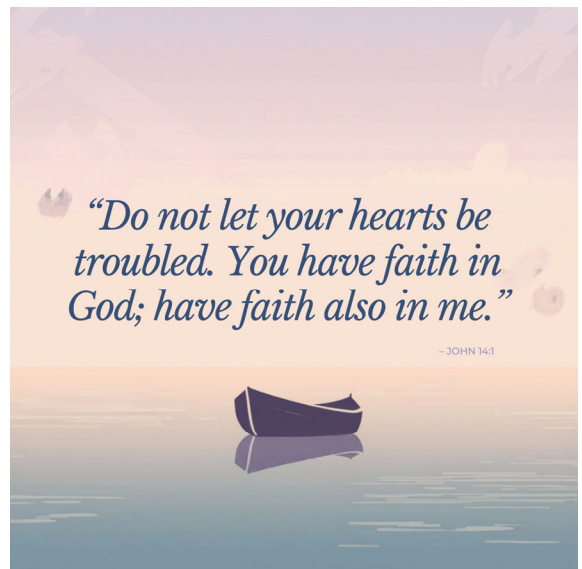
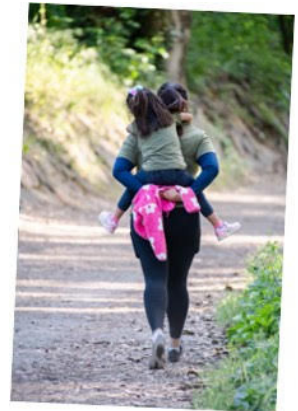

A follow up letter will be sent from Fr. Romeo to all registered parishioners this month.

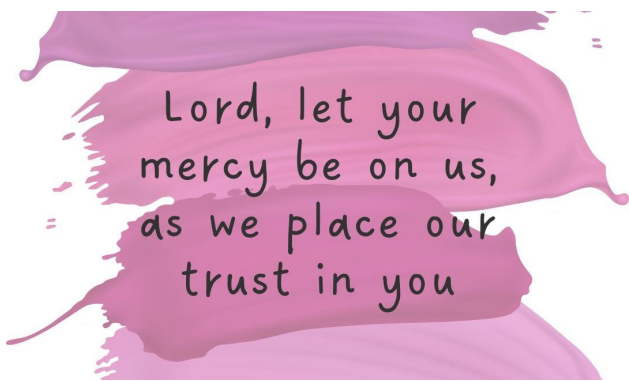

Much Ado About Nothing July 11, 2:00 PM preview One of Shakespeare's wittiest and most beloved comedies. We strive to be a community of faith where all are welcomed, nourished, and empowered to be Christ for others.



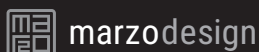
