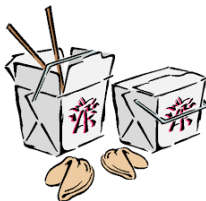

IDAHO MISSION TRIP

June 14—22, 2026

This year, 21 of our teens, young adults, and chaperones will be heading to Lapwai, Idaho for an annual mission trip. This will be the fourteenth year that Deborah & Hal Rovick have led our youth and made the journey via car, train, and van to help serve the Nez Perce Tribe. Over the years they have developed a relationship of trust with the native people. Our youth will be working on several projects this year. In the past, we have constructed handicap ramps for the elders of the tribe, rebuilt the Trading Post, assembled a play structure, painted homes, replaced floors and built and raised 2 shade/weather structures.

How can you help? You can participate in our trip in several ways, without leaving home!

- You can pray for the group and the people of the Nez Perce Tribe. Each workday at noon the group will be praying The Angelus.
- **You can participate in our fundraiser after the masses on May 23 & 24**, by leaving a donation and putting your name on a rock or a nail, which will be used in the projects that we will work on during our mission trip.

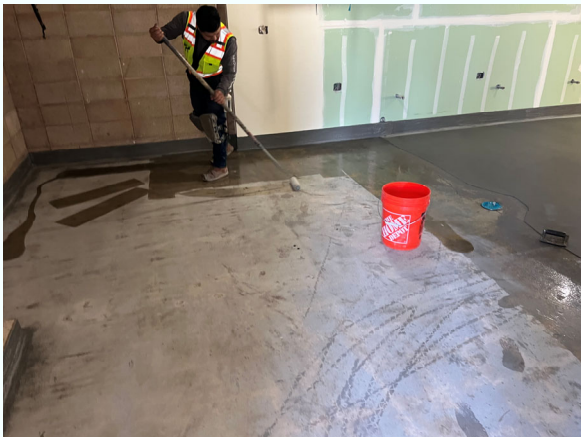
