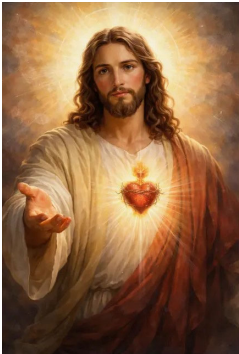

Santa Cruz Shakespeare 2026 Summer Festival

Much Ado About Nothing July 11, 2:00 PM preview One of Shakespeare's wittiest and most beloved comedies.
