Santa Cruz Shakespeare 2026 Summer Festival

Much Ado About Nothing July 11, 2:00 PM preview One of Shakespeare's wittiest and most beloved comedies. Of all the couples in Shakespeare, perhaps none is more widely loved than Beatrice and Benedict. Their battle of wits, their antagonism turned to eroticism, their history. The audience, like the other characters in the play, wait with excitement as their wits clash, and eventually, as their love blossoms.

Its central couple, ironically, is one of Shakespeare's happiest. A powerful unit, wildly in love with each other, the Macbeths follow the insinuations of the witches – the famous weird sisters – and commit murder in the name of their shared ambition: the throne of Scotland. But even with their goal achieved, Macbeth's paranoia and guilt lead him further down the road of blood.

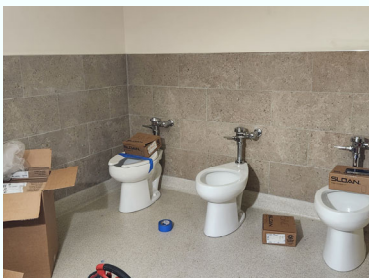

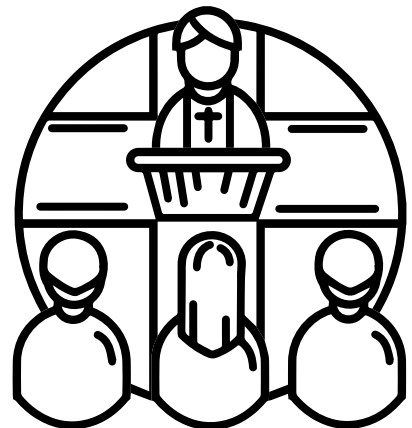
