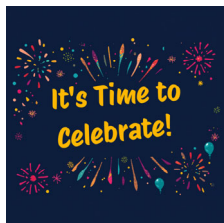


Markey Community Center Office Update - How to Reach Us

Idaho Mission Trip—Lapwai 2026

A Most Productive Year

Usually when we talk about the Lapwai Mission/service trip we talk about all the complications. Rain (usually on packing day), train delays (sometimes overnight) and other camp or travel issues (we could write an book).

This year we had none of these issues but what stands out most is what you and we accomplished in four days of work.

There were three main tasks and one added extra. All involved were elders and all had tragedies or illnesses in their lives. Here they are by name:

- **Julia** had lost her husband of many years within this year. Since that time she had fallen twice. Once from her front porch entry and once on her collapsing back deck. We removed the back deck, recycling what we could. We rebuilt a smaller sturdier one with an access ramp at her front porch and back deck. The crew was careful to use the nails and rocks you purchased at every stage. When they were done she could use both ramps with handrails to bring in groceries and load firewood.
- **Cal** was the town repair man fixing all manner of small engines along with other oddities. He contracted severe pneumonia for which he was slowly recovering. His two daughters asked us to help him. He came out and visited the crew with his oxygen in tow. We built him an access ramp from his front porch. We also replaced two small broken down stairs and at his request built a small deck on the side of his house so he could watch the sunrise and the stars. His daughters were ecstatic.
- **Valerie's** request for a wire fence and gates to keep her dog in and her neighbor kids out of her garden was different for us but we don't question what we are asked to do. She had told us the story of her grandson who had struggled with drug issues but had reformed and was involved in the tribe and her again. Sadly he had passed in an act of violence a few months before. It was a beautiful job led by our own Mark Wegrich. When we were done Valerie hugged me for a long time, weeping. "My grandson was going to build this fence before he died. He will be so happy to know that you finished it for him".
- **Extra Task:** replacement of windows in the home of the place where we camp.

Uneventfully we returned home tired but satisfied. As you should be for all your support. God bless all.

Comments on Lapwai 2026 for Resurrection Parish

Elijah Swanson

I began mission work in 2022 with Resurrection and what would become C3 work service (C3 = Crazy California Catholics). It's been 5 years now and there's been a lot of change in the world at large and my own life. People I thought would stay, left. And those I thought would be around only for a year, stay. This June I saw Lapwai for the first time again through the eyes of people who came for the first time or those who only came once before. To them I wanted to point out everything I wish I knew as a fresh eyes adventurer straight out of high school: the human element. It's never a project. It's never *just* a project. There's a person, a story, and a tragedy. Widows, cancer patients, victims of natural disasters, and any number of other tales. But also their tales of resistance and restoration, of faith and hope, upholding ancient traditions and fighting against the American genocide engine for their tribal sovereignty. And then to see how over the past 16 years we've played a role in their stories, the only word is humbling, the kind that puts everything into perspective. It is the humility amidst such love and trials and human lives and connection that one hears most clearly the voice of God.
